

ORDINANCE NO. 17-31

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY REPEALING THE CITY'S FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE (APPENDIX O IN THE DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE) AND ENACTING A REPLACEMENT FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE TO BE CODIFIED AS APPENDIX O IN THE DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the federal regulations governing construction within areas identified as flood plains, and the federal maps establishing the location and extent of those areas have likewise been modified; and

WHEREAS, the City's Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance is required to be modified accordingly in order to comply with federal flood plain insurance requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

SECTION I

The City's Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, codified as Appendix O in the Development Ordinance, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II

The attached Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, incorporated herein as though here set forth in full, is hereby enacted as the City's Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, and same shall be codified as Appendix O in the Development Ordinance.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment following second reading, and publication in accordance with the requirements of applicable Kentucky law.


