CONSUMER FIREWORKS APPLICATION GUIDE

Step 1. Submit Required Document to Kentucky Division of Fire Prevention:

- Fireworks Registration Application
- Storage Notification Report

IMPORTANT: Copies of all State of Kentucky issued licensing will be required upon submission. **Applications submitted without all required documents will not be processed.**

Step 2. Submit the following required documentation to the City of Richmond:

Completed packets can be submitted to the Codes, Planning, Safety & Risk Management Department,

Monday - Friday from 8 am to 4:30 pm.

- All State issued licensing
- Completed Business License application with the \$500.00 license fee
- Completed Certificate of Occupancy application with the \$30.00 permit fee
- Proof of General Liability Insurance
- Proof that sales person(s) are at least 18 years of age
- Copy of lease allowing sales to take place on the property
